Free Places for Patients to Stay

If you are a cancer patient at the QEII Hospital in Halifax, you can stay at *The Lodge That Gives* or *Point Pleasant Lodge* for free during your treatment. If you need a place to stay, let the booking clerk know when you receive your treatment schedule.

The Lodge That Gives is located behind the Nova Scotia Cancer Centre. There are single and double rooms with private washrooms. A family member or support person can stay for \$55 per night. In certain situations, that fee may be waived (e.g. parents coming with a child, caregiver of a transplant patient, or families with financial hardship). First time reservations must be made by:

- A booking clerk at the Nova Scotia Cancer Centre
- A family physician
- A cancer specialist
- A Cancer Patient Navigator

Parking at the Lodge is limited. It is available on a first come, first served basis. Meals are provided at no cost. The Lodge also offers internet, hairdressing, support groups and activities.



Point Pleasant Lodge

Point Pleasant Lodge is located one block from the QEII Hospital. It is within walking distance but a shuttle bus is also available to and from the hospital. Patients receiving treatment at the QEII Hospital can stay at Point Pleasant Lodge for free during their treatment. The reservation must be made by a booking clerk at the QEII Hospital.

Additional charges apply for each guest, unless a person is confirmed to be an “essential escort” by the booking clerk at the time of the reservation.

You must contact Point Pleasant Lodge before 10 a.m. on the day of your arrival to confirm your reservation. There is limited parking at Point Pleasant Lodge. The cost of parking is \$7.00/day plus tax. Parking is available on the first come, first served basis. Most of the rooms are double rooms. Patients who are staying at the lodge on their own may be asked to share a double room with someone of the same gender. There is a charge for meals. Meal vouchers for cancer patients and essential escorts are available through the Nova Scotia Cancer Centre.
