

Where can I park? How much will it cost?

The Nova Scotia Cancer Centre is located at the VG site of the QEII Hospital in Halifax. You have two choices for parking:

- Two pay parking lots at the VG site
- Meters on the streets surrounding the VG site

Are there special parking rates for cancer patients?

Both inpatients and outpatients of the NS Cancer Centre and Hematology programs can get parking vouchers. To be eligible for a voucher, you must have treatments at the hospital for at least 14 days in a row.

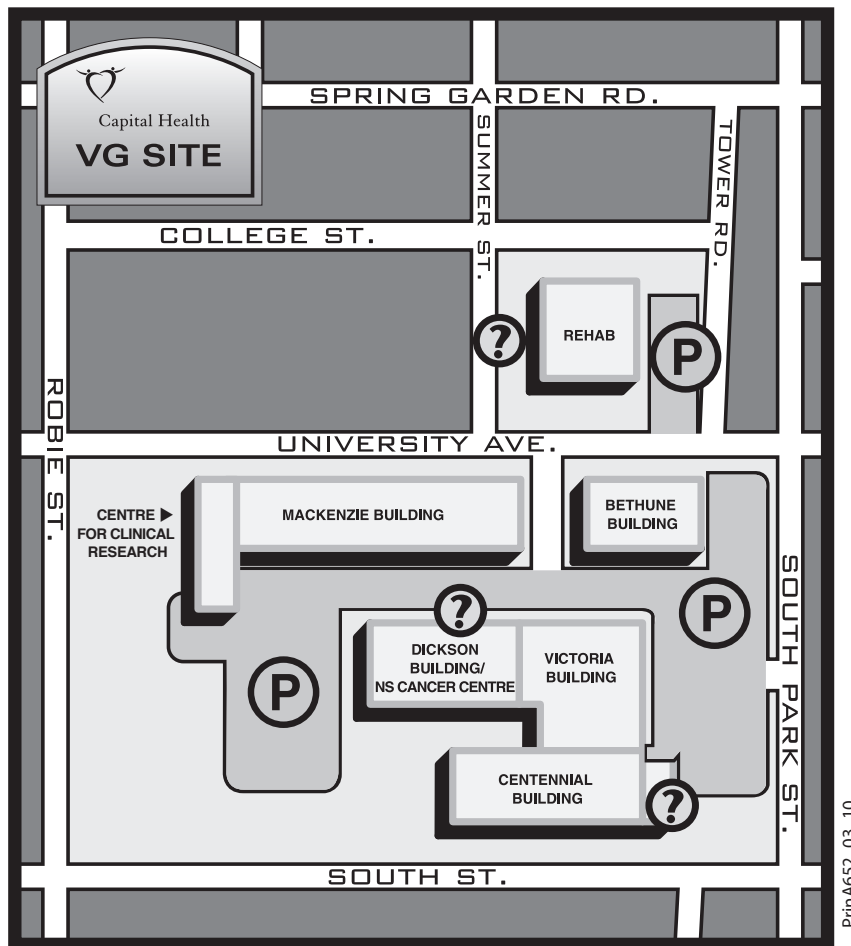
Parking vouchers provide 50% off the daily parking rate. You can get a parking voucher application form from your unit or clinic reception desk.

If you do not have treatments at the hospital for at least 14 days in a row and are having trouble with the cost of parking, ask for a referral to the social worker.

How much does it cost to park in the VG site lots?

The parking rates for the VG site lots are listed below. Rates are charged per 1/2 hour or part thereof:

- \$1.25 first 1/2 hour
- \$1.25 second 1/2 hour
- \$1.25 third 1/2 hour
- \$1.25 fourth 1/2 hour
- \$1.00 each additional 1/2 hour
- \$12.00 Daily Maximum (\$4.00 Maximum on weekends)

What is the cost of parking on the street near the VG?

Parking meters in Halifax charge \$0.25 for every ten minutes. They are colour coded. The colour tells you the maximum time for parking:

- **Red:** 30 minutes
- **Silver/Grey:** 90 minutes
- **Green:** 2 hours
- **Yellow:** 3-5 hours
