### CCNS LEADERSHIP EXCELLENCE

#### QUALIFICATIONS

- The individual or group's leadership has resulted in a substantial contribution to cancer control in the province
- The individual or group has led, or through their actions, has inspired a change in policy that has resulted in reducing cancer risk

### CCNS INNOVATION EXCELLENCE

#### QUALIFICATIONS

- The individual or group has recognized a challenge and used 'out-of-the-box' thinking to improve the cancer system.
- The individual's or group's innovation(s) has positively impacted the cancer system

### CCNS EXCELLENCE IN PATIENT CARE

#### QUALIFICATIONS

- The individual or group has substantially improved some aspect of care for cancer patients
- The individual or group has contributed to assuring patient-centred care is at the forefront of the health care agenda

*Please note:* This award is for a health professional or group providing direct patient care.

The two letters of support for this nomination must be from co-workers and/or patients. Letters must provide examples of ways in which the nominee has improved patient care.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR NOMINATION?

- Health Professionals
- Health Administrators
- Researchers
- Volunteers
- Advocates
- Nominees may be working or retired
- Nominees may be present or former residents of Nova Scotia

Both individual and group/ team nominations will be considered. Posthumous nominations will also be considered.

- Nomination and supporting letters should speak to and provide examples of how the nominee has met each of the qualifications outlined
